



Due to vendor service changes, Paper Recycling has changed at the Convenience Stations-Petersville (11110 25th Street)/Harrison (10293 Old Nashville Road) and Landfill (811 E County Road 450 South). Paper is still collected at the locations above but is now collected in the commingled containers along with plastics, metals, and glass. Paper, separated individually, is accepted at the Columbus/Bartholomew County Recycling Center, 720 South Mapleton Street. 


