




The following items can be recycled:

   No ribbons, bows, foil/shiny paper, or tissue paper
- CHRISTMAS LIGHTS strand lights only
  (as part of our Electronics program at the Landfill or Recycling Center)
- CHRISTMAS TREES live trees; remove decorations, lights & stands (bring to the Yard Waste Site adjacent to the Recycling Center)



Don't forget - you can recycle old electronics at the Columbus/Bartholomew Recycling Center or Bartholomew County Landfill! (\$20 fee for computer monitors & TVs)











## **Hours Change**



### 2026 Landfill Fees

Starting Friday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026 Landfill fees at the Bartholomew County Landfill,811 E 450 S, will increase to \$39.00/ton.



(Residential tire recycling of up to 6 passenger size for Bartholomew County residential household) at the Bartholomew County Landfill, 811 E CR 450 S. Address verification required. Over 6 tires are accepted at Landfill, disposal costs of \$3 or more per the fee schedule at https://www.bcswmd.com/landfill.php

### 2026 Board Meeting Dates




